The regular meeting of the Board of Township Trustees, Newbury Township was called to order at 7:00 p.m., May14, 2014, with Ms. Blair, Mr. Skomrock and Mr. Quigley present.

Minutes of the April 16, 2014 were approved by a motion by Mr. Skomrock, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Ms. Blair and a unanimous affirmative vote by all.

Ms. Mansfield presented the April 2014 financials for approval. Ms. Blair motioned to approve the financials as presented, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mr. Skomrock, and a unanimous affirmative vote by all.

Mr. Gorris, from the County Engineers office, reported on Kimmeridge signage. He indicated that there were not too many signs, but there are some signs that need to be relocated and repaired. He will send a report to the Township.

Mr. Gorris reported on the easement for the Southwest corner of 87 and Auburn. A motion to accept the easement made by Ms. Blair, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mr. Skomrock and a unanimous affirmative vote by all.

The bids were taken by Mr. Gorris for review by the County Engineer.

Mr. Gorris reported that back in 1960 there was a court order that the township had to take over Kiwanis Lake Road maintenance. This discussion was held due to some residents on private roads requesting that the Township maintain their private roads.

Mr. Schneider attended the meeting requesting public records. Ms. Mansfield indicated that she had just received the request and was checking with the prosecutor on exactly what could be done. Mr. Skomrock will attend a meeting with Mr. Schneider at 8:30 AM on Thursday May 15, 2014.

Mr. Ule presented a quote for the repaving of Munn Road Cemetery. The quote includes the Township responsibilities and GAR paving's responsibilities. The quote is for \$8,600 for equipment and operators, then the township would need to add the asphalt at approximately \$17,000.

Mr. Uhl spoke on the Rec Board. The Burton Rotary and Carter Lumber donated time and materials for back stops on fields 2 & 3. Enrollment is way down for registrations to play sports.

Mr. Zimperman reported 50 calls in April for the Fire Department; they will have breakfast for the veterans on Memorial Day.

Mr. Zimperman reported for the Road Department plows are cleaned up and painted, and ready for summer storage, They are currently working on ditching, flooding problems on some road due

to debris in ditches, they are cleaning ditches to clean up the problem. They will start prepping the roads for paving. Cemeteries are being cleaned up. Topsoil was purchased for cemetery use.

Mr. Skomrock reported that the county drug and alcohol policy has been revised. We have revised manuals for the road employees. They are to sign off and return the sheet indicating that they received the manual.

Mr. Skomrock discussed the Ohio Public Works Grants. Burton Twp. would like to work with Newbury on Hotchkiss Road. The second choice would be Pekin.

Mr. Mansfield reported for the Park Board, Auburn Fence is working on the back stop; prices are being collected for the electric on the pavilion. The veteran's park sign was installed. Trails were cleaned up.

Ms. Hrabak reported on Stone Road house that will be taken down using Moving Ohio Forward Grant. Motion to sign contract for demolition of structures at 14530 Stone Road was made by Ms. Blair, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mr. Skomrock and a unanimous affirmative vote by all.

Ms. Blair discussed the workers compensation discounts. We were recognized by the Geauga County Safety Council for our safety last year.

Ms. Blair indicated that the bakery would be opening approximately in October. It will be next to Subway.

Mr. Quigley has an application for a sign variance for the Veterans Park. Motion to waive its fee for the zoning was made by Ms. Blair, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mr. Skomrock, and a unanimous affirmative vote by all.

Mr. Schwarz has done the consolidation of the Road Department; a new plat map is needed.

Mr. Quigley attended the Newbury Community Church meeting and indicated that they are glad of the new Veterans Park and if necessary they would find somewhere else to hold the craft and clutter sale.

Ms. Blair indicated that the Kiwanis wanted to make a donation and have a fund raiser for the Veterans Park.

Mr. Quigley showed a landscape plan for the Veterans Park.

Mr. Quigley then discussed and reviewed portions of the employee manual.
